### Terrorist Attack on Sunbury Farm Leaves Over 1300 Farm Animals Dead

The number of farm animals now dead from the Stahl Mink Farm terrorist attack stands at over 1300 dead farm animals. Nearby farmers report hundreds of chickens were killed by the nasty mink who killed their chickens “for fun and not for food”. Over 1000 mink died from many causes: they were slaughtered on heavily traveled State Route 890, died from shock, stress, and trauma often leading to starvation, and were wounded by canine bites from dogs and coyotes. Others perished from intestinal enteritis from ingesting abnormal levels of Bacteria from ground contact.

The U.S. Congress passed a federal law on Nov 27, 2006. The *Animal Enterprise Terrorism Act* that protects farmers in all 50 states. Wikipedia Reports:

The law amends the Animal Enterprise Protection Act of 1992 (Pub. L Public Law (United States) [102–346](#)) and gives the [U.S. Department of Justice](#) greater authority to target [animal rights activists](#). The AETA does so by broadening the definition of "animal enterprise" to include academic and commercial enterprises that use or sell animals or animal products. It also increases the existing penalties, includes penalties based on the amount of economic damage caused, and allows animal enterprises to seek restitution. The law was originally introduced in the [109th Congress](#) by [Thomas Petri](#) (R-WI) and Senators [Dianne Feinstein](#) (D-CA) and [Jim Inhofe](#) (R-OK). The final version of the bill, S. 3880.,<sup>[2]</sup> was passed in the [United States Senate](#) on September 29, 2006, by [unanimous consent](#).

The Sunbury Terrorists face 5-10 years federal imprisonment according to the AETC federal law.

PA Law - Section 3503.0 - Title 18 - CRIMES AND OFFENSES *Criminal Trespass and Agriculture Trespasser* are felonies with additional state prison sentences.

**The reward for information leading to their arrest is now \$22,000**
