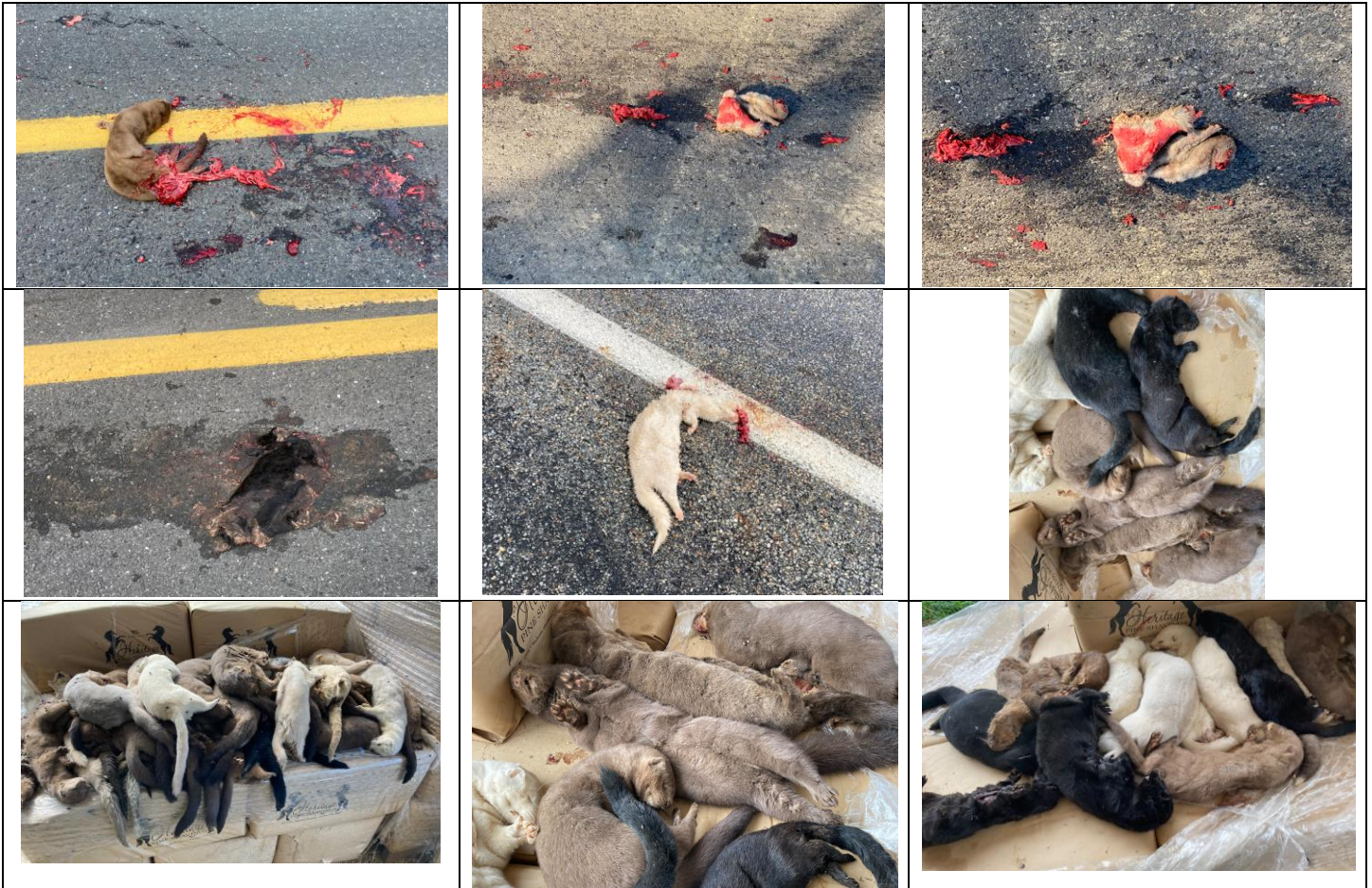

Animal Liberators Commit the Bloodiest Farm Crime Ever....

And folks wonder if local, state, and federal law enforcement officials really care. Over 1000 farm raised mink at the Sunbury area Richard H. Stahl Sons Inc Mink Farm **were killed and began dying** before the farm owners knew anyone raided their mink farm. The Sunbury Animal Hospital called them at 6:55 AM on Sunday September 17 and reported their mink were being slaughtered by vehicles on state route 890. The most heinous farm crime in Pennsylvania is now seen in these photos taken by the farm owners Mark and John Stahl.

The current Northumberland County District Attorney and the current lead investigator for the Pa State Police have never visited the crime scene. Neither have the FBI nor state officials from Harrisburg including the Pa Department of Agriculture, and the Attorney General's Office. A Pa Game Commission Game Warden visited the farm two days later. Evidence found within 48 hours of this bloody crime has been turned over to the DA's office and the Stonington State Police, but they have been unable to solve the crime in the past 88 days. WHY? The reward for information leading to the arrest of these farm animal killers remains at \$22,000.
